North Hollywood

Fly to Los Angeles, the 'City of Angels'. Head for North Hollywood, where you will enter the world of glitz and glam, it's everything you ever imagined it would be. Here, everyone's a rockstar! We recommend a stay in The Garland in North Hollywood, opened by legendary Hollywood actress Beverly Garland in 1972. This hotel has great transportation links to the rest of the city, the Metro line is just a 10-minute walk from the hotel, so you can be strolling along the Hollywood walk of fame in no time! You'll want to pre-book your Universal Studios Hollywood tickets for your stay here. Just a short, might I add complimentary, tram ride away from The Garland. Here, you can be the star and go behind the scenes of some of the world's best-known films and tv series. Universal Studios Hollywood is still a working film studio so you never know who you might see! You can attend dive-in movies at The Garland, where kids of all ages can enjoy a classic flick daily in the summer and weekends year-round.

Anaheim

For those looking for a bit more adventure, drive an hour down the 101 and 15 to Anaheim for a few nights and visit the world-famous Disneyland California. Home to the newly opened Avengers Campus, where you can sling webs with Spidey, meet your favorite characters like Cap or grab a bite to eat at PYM's Test Kitchen, the options are unlimited and that's without even mentioning the rest of the two parks! Huntington Beach

Depart Los Angeles
